

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Anderson County Commissioners Court will conduct a public hearing at its regularly scheduled meeting to consider and to act upon a renewal, re-affirmation and ratification of its Guidelines and Criteria on July 27, 2026, to renew, reaffirm and ratify its Guidelines and Criteria for Tax Abatement, pursuant to the provisions of the Property Redevelopment and Tax Abatement Act, Chapter 312 of the Texas Tax Code.

In determining whether to renew, re-affirm and ratify its Guidelines and Criteria for Tax Abatement, the Commissioners Court will consider whether the Guidelines and Criteria promote economic development in compliance with Texas Tax Code §312.001 et seq. and that development in conformity with the Guidelines and Criteria would contribute to the retention or expansion of primary employment or would attract major investment in the zone that would be a benefit to the property to be included in the zone and would contribute to the economic development of Anderson County.

The public hearing will take place at the Anderson County Courthouse Annex, at 9:30 a.m. on July 27, 2026, in the Commissioner's Courtroom, 703 N. Mallard Street, Palestine, Texas. All interested persons may appear, and present testimony and evidence regarding the renewal of Tax Abatement Guidelines and Criteria
